Parallel sessions last 1.5 hours. If there are 5 papers, we suggest that the chair allocate 15 minutes for the presentation and 3 minutes for audience questions. If there are 4 papers, it is possible to allocate up to 18 minutes for the presentation and 4 minutes for audience questions. Finally, for sessions with 3 papers (mainly organized sessions), presentations can last up to 25 minutes with 5 minutes for audience questions.
